RELATIONSHIPS: The Key to Successful Discipleship

Some of the myths of successful discipleship have been a history of chasing the "next best thing" when it comes to a program or a routine for helping people on their journey of faith. This is a myth that I have fallen into as a pastor. As I have continued in ministry and in the call to make Christ-like disciples, I have learned that discipleship is all about relationships.

Jimmy Dodd (*Survive or Thrive*), writes about 6 relationships that every pastor needs to thrive. I believe that this does not just apply to pastors, but rather everyone that desires to help someone else on this journey of grace. One such relationship that Dodd mentions is that of a "mentor." This mentor is someone that can bring wisdom to your life and walk with you through the journey from time to time. As I think about this relationship from Scripture and then try to apply it to our life I think of someone like Paul. Before Paul was mentoring other great leaders, Saul had to be mentored and helped along by Barnabas. This man saw what God saw in Paul and continued to pour into his life. Paul then passes along that trait with Timothy, as well as many others.

One key to successful discipleship must be the relationship between mentor and mentee. Who is pouring into your life? Who is your "Paul"? Who are you pouring your faith into? Who is your "Timothy"?
