Mateo 8 y 9 están llenos de historias del poder sobrenatural de Cristo para hablar de sanidad en las vidas de las personas: un leproso es sanado, la fe de un centurión para ver a Jesús sanar a su siervo, la suegra de Pedro sanada, una tormenta furiosa calmada, dos hombres poseídos por demonios sanados, un hombre paralítico perdonado y restaurado, una niña muerta resucitada, Una mujer con un trastorno hemorrágico a largo plazo sanó, milagro tras milagro. Lo sobrenatural de Dios provocado por la palabra y el toque de Jesús. Y en medio de todo esto, Dios llama a Mateo de su vida de recaudación de impuestos a una vida de "tomar la cruz" para convertirse en su discípulo. El llamado y la transformación de Mateo, un recaudador de impuestos, es sobrenatural. No es solo el lugar común, es lo inesperado. Mateo no era el que la gente elegiría para seguir a Jesús, pero el pasado de Mateo, su ocupación, su asociación con los romanos no impidieron que Jesús viera las posibilidades de que Mateo se convirtiera en su discípulo.

Nosotros tampoco debemos permitir que el pasado, la ocupación, las asociaciones, las acciones o actitudes no cristianas de una persona nos impidan ver las posibilidades y el potencial de que alguien se convierta en un seguidor de Jesucristo.

Que nuestra oración sea siempre, Señor, ayúdame a ver las posibilidades en las personas que traes a mi camino. Ayúdame a mirar más allá de los muros de la iglesia, a ver lo que Jesús ve.



BASIC CAMP RULES

1. Respect yourself, respect others, and respect the campground.
2. Use language that is appropriate and respectful to all.
3. Take care of the campground. Campers and their parents will be responsible for the cost of repairs for any damage to the property of facilities.
4. Dress modestly. Remember that we are representing Christ.
5. Be in your designated, scheduled area. Male and female campers or counselors are not allowed in each other's rooms.
6. DO NOT BRING, cell phones, alcohol, tobacco products, weapons, knives, or electronic devices (iPods, iPads, laptops, MP3's, etc.)
7. All medication MUST be given to the camp nurse at registration. (Please send medications in the original container with detailed pharmacist instructions.)
8. Serious infractions of rules may result in the camper going home.
9. No one other than registered campers, counselors, and camp personnel are allowed on the camp grounds at any time without special permission from the camp director.

- Casual/play clothes including a light jacket or sweatshirt
- Personal items (toothbrush, soap, deodorant, etc.)
- Pillow and sleeping bag (or twin bedding)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Phone calls: Due to the issue of homesickness, it has become the policy of our camp to not allow campers to call home. We do all we can to help campers through this time. We have counselors, a nurse, and others who will comfort and help campers who may encounter homesickness. If we feel your camper is not adjusting to 'camp life,' we will contact you to decide if your camper should finish out the week. If you do not hear from us, then you know all is well!
- **Inhalers and Epi-Pens** ONLY these medications will be given to your camper's counselor so they are readily available to your camper if needed. These items MUST be checked in with the camp nurse and will be distributed by the camp nurse following registration.
